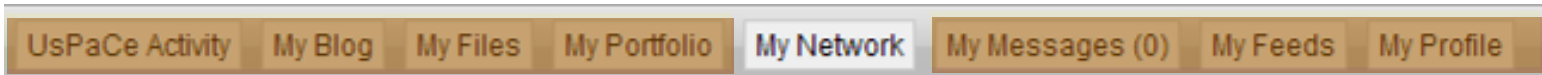

#5 My Network



What is it and what can you do with it?

The My Network page is where you can quickly find your friends, tutors and other users along with communities of which you are a member of.

You can also create your own access groups in this section. This is really handy for when you come to choose who can see your files/pages/etc.

For example you may want to add your tutors into a group called “tutors”. This could be used for sharing things only between you and your tutors. You could also create a group called “all course people” which would allow you to share with all your course mates and tutors. It’s up to you!!
