

Adding items to Del.icio.us using the bookmark link on websites


An increasing number of websites have bookmark links on them which allow you to quickly bookmark pages using social bookmarking tools such as Del.icio.us.

This quick tutorial shows you how you can do it.

To begin I am looking at a government website. If I scroll down to the bottom of the page you can see there are some buttons which allow you to quickly add a bookmark. Click on the Delicious link on the left hand side.
